Getting from the airport to the hotels

The cheapest way of travelling from the airport to the centre is by train (railway station in airport). The train airport service makes stops in Brussels North, Brussels Centre and Brussels South. All three hotels are within walking distance of Brussels South Station.

A taxi trip from the airport to the centre of Brussels would cost approximately 30 euros.

location of hotels and HONIM



The centre of Brussels is the pentangle in the middle.

In the south, close to Brussels South Station, are the hotels most conference participants are in.

HONIM is situated in the upper left corner, close to metro stop **SIMONIS**.

Getting to HONIM

The conference takes place at HONIM, a Brussels school of applied sciences close to the Basilica of the Sacred Heart in Koekelberg.

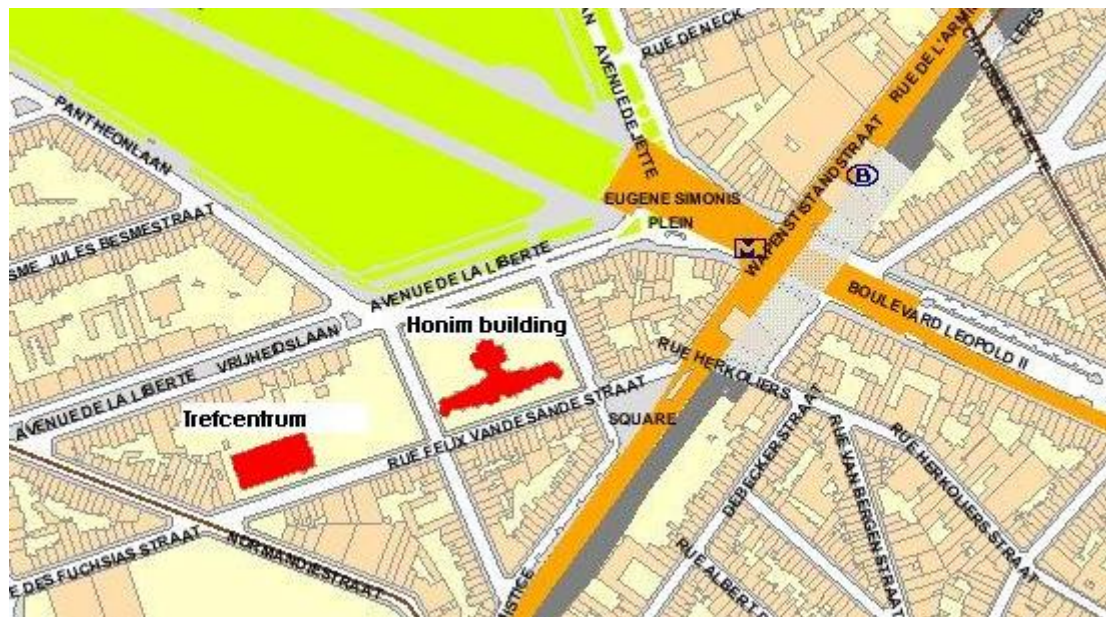

HONIM is some 300 metres from metro stop SIMONIS.

Metro line 2 runs from Brussels South Station to SIMONIS (the last stop), a 15 minute trip. The hotels are at a 15 minute walking distance from South Station.

Travelling on the Brussels metro is cheapest if you take the card "JUMP 10": it gives you 10 rides for 10,50 euros.
